Despite our desperate need for affordable housing, the state has spent or reserved \$146 million in tax credits to subsidize more than 5000 market rate and luxury units in Gateway Cities through the Housing Development Incentive Program (HDIP). Even as we face the threat of federal cutbacks and a difficult state fiscal situation, the commonwealth plans to annually spend another \$30 million taxpayer dollars on market rate HDIP projects with almost no affordable units. Yet, the key question remains unanswered: why is the state spending precious resources on high end housing? For more information see the Mass.
